Clinical Audit (selected)

Chronic Kidney Disease (Audit) 2013: Based on CKD NICE Guidelines Sep 2008. I looked at the records of all patients with CKD as per eGFR results. A few things were looked at: whether those patients were recorded as CKD, and what stage; I also

looked at warnings about their medications and how often they were getting blood tests done for follow up purposes. I eventually created a template for EMIS web computer programme to prompt GP's to act on their CKD patients as per the NICE guidelines.

Thyroid Function Tests (Audit and Re-audit) Oct 2011-April 2012: Looked at the records of all the hypothyroid patients in the practice and picked up on those who missed their annual thyroid function tests, and did a re-audit. The recall system was analysed and improved: where a template of the blood test required is now attached to the recall letter.

Nursing Home communication paperwork audit 2009: Looked at correspondence letters sent from nursing homes to medical practitioners, and analysed the information provided. I then came up with a template for correspondence for all the surrounding nursing homes. A re-audit was to be carried out six months later, to analyse the implications of the template correspondence on the quality of care received.
