Education and Early Life

- Enrolled at the **Iraqi College of Medicine** in Baghdad in 1938
 - Completed his medical studies and graduated from the College of Medicine

Career and Positions

- Worked as a surgeon and professor of surgery, training and teaching medical students
 - First Iraqi doctor to receive the **Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons of London**
 - Served as **Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Jordan** from 1981 to 1984
 - Appointed **Minister of Health in Iraq** in September 1965
 - Held important administrative and academic roles, including Chair of the Surgery Department
 - Contributed to the establishment of specialized surgery programs in Iraq

Scientific and Cultural Contributions

- Authored several works on medical history and ancient medicine, including:
 - *Medicine in Ancient Iraq*
 - *Medicine in Assyria* (1976)
 - *Medicine among the Arabs*
 - Published research articles in Arabic journals on topics such as ancient medicine, diagnosis and prognosis, and medical education
